Nelson Laboratories, Inc. is excited to inform you that we have started the expansion of our current facility in Salt Lake City, Utah. The expansion will provide two floors of office space for relocation of our administrative functions, thereby allowing us to expand many of our laboratory areas in the existing building. We anticipate the completion of the expansion to be in the later part of Fall 2009.

In preparation to utilize this new space for optimal efficiency, we will begin transitioning some of our laboratory areas from the second floor of our current building to the first floor of our current building. We have carefully evaluated which tests can be re-located in order to minimize impact on turn-around time and service quality. We have created an overall move plan with estimated time frames that includes an assessment of which equipment will be re-qualified and the re-validation efforts needed to ensure the conduct of the testing in the new area is not impacted. The approval and re-qualification/validation assessment for each move will be documented through our change management process. We do not anticipate that these moves will have any material impact on the quality of testing we know you expect.

The first phase of the move involves the Microbial Identification lab area. Our move plan is structured such that we do not anticipate any delays or impact on your testing. After all the moves are completed, we will prepare an executive summary of the re-qualification/validation information that will be available to our clients. This will provide traceability and closure of the change and ensure you that we have conducted these moves in accordance with GMP regulations. The estimated completion date for the move to be completed is April 2009.
